

IS YOUR HEART LIKE GOD'S HEART?

SERMON SUMMARY

The sermon focused on the themes of God's love for the world, the impending judgment, and the call for believers to be witnesses. Pastor Clark emphasized that God loves all people and desires for everyone to come to repentance through Jesus Christ. He also warned of the coming judgment as described in Revelation, urging the congregation to be aware of the signs and to turn to God. The sermon concluded with a call to action for believers to be active witnesses, sharing the gospel with all nations and participating in outreach efforts like Operation Christmas Child.
