SERMON TOPIC: The King is Coming

SERMON SUMMARY

The sermon focuses on Revelation 22, the final chapter of the Bible, discussing God's ultimate plan for eternity. The pastor emphasizes three main points: God's final situation (describing the new heaven and earth), His final admonition (warnings about Christ's return), and His final invitation to salvation. The message centers on the theme that Jesus is coming back and the importance of being ready for His return.

- 1. Jesus is coming back suddenly and we need to be ready
- 2. God's Word is complete and perfect we shouldn't add to or take away from it In eternity, believers will see God face to face and serve Him with pure motives
- 4. The invitation to come to Jesus is still open today, but won't be forever

- Why do you think God included both promises and warnings in this final chapter?
- How does the image of 'no more night' (Rev 22:5) encourage you in your current circumstances?
- What does it mean to be part of the 'bride' that says 'Come' (Rev 22:17)? How can we maintain an eternal perspective in our daily lives?
- What specific changes might God be calling you to make in light of His promised return?
