What Is God Like?

SERMON SUMMARY

This week we are focusing on Psalm 139 and exploring the nature of God. God is perceptive, present, powerful, purposeful, and pure. He knows everything about us, is always with us, and has a purpose for each of our lives. It's important to recognize God's omniscience, omnipresence, and omnipotence, and understand how these attributes can transform our lives. The message concluded with a call to invite God into our hearts, to search us, and to lead us in the way of everlasting life.

KEY VERSES

Psalm 139: 1-4; (NLT) "O Lord, you have examined my heart and know everything about me. 2You know when I sit down or stand up. You know my thoughts even when I'm far away. 3You see me when I travel and when I rest at home. You know everything I do. 4You know what I am going to say even before I say it, Lord." *Additional verses:* Psalm 139:13-19; 23-24

Jeremiah 9:23-24 (NLT) - "This is what the Lord says: 'Don't let the wise boast in their wisdom, or the powerful boast in their power, or the rich boast in their riches. 24But those who wish to boast should boast in this alone:that they truly know me and understand that I am the Lord who demonstrates unfailing love and who brings justice and righteousness to the earth, and that I delight in these things. I, the Lord, have spoken!"

QUESTIONS

- 1. What stood out to you the most from today's sermon?
- 2. How does knowing that God is omniscient (all-knowing) affect your daily life?
- 3. Can you share a time when you felt God's presence in a powerful way?
- 4. What does it mean to you that God has a purpose for your life?
- 5. How can we better align our lives with God's purpose for us?
- 6. Why is it important to recognize both God's love and His holiness?
- 7. How can we invite God to search our hearts and reveal any offensive ways in us?
- 8. What steps can we take this week to deepen our relationship with God?

This week, take time each day to invite God to search your heart and reveal any areas that need change. Write down what He reveals to you and pray for His guidance and strength to make those changes. Remember that God is omniscient and knows everything about us. He is omnipresent and is always with us. He is omnipotent and has the power to do anything. God has a purpose for each of our lives.
